Shifts are filled on a first come, first served basis and can be mailed, faxed, emailed, or brought into the office.

Most volunteer shifts are 3 to 4 hours long. Anyone volunteering for two full shifts will receive a coupon for \$5 off one 2017 clothing item <u>and</u> may opt to receive one Adult All Event 3-day pass. Site Managers may opt to receive **two** Adult All Event 3-day passes.

CASHIERS: Ticket Sales (Adorni and Muni) and Merchandise Sales (Muni). Experience preferred, but RCMF *requires and will provide cashier training*.
